

The Training Institute for Medical Emergencies & Rescue Presents THE FALL 2024 BASIC EMT COURSE



PREREQUISITES:

Candidates must be 17 years old by 1/31/2025, have no criminal history (10NYCRR-800.6 F) **Must be able to read, write, and comprehend English.**

SYNOPSIS:

The EMT Course includes Defibrillation as an advanced skill. This course reflects the New National EMS Standards, and will educate the student in anatomy, physiology, triage & treatment of trauma patients, CPR, patient assessment, m e d i c a I emergencies, childbirth, pediatrics, geriatrics, pharmacology, psychological emergencies, extrication, & introduction to Haz-Mat, WMD, & Terrorism. There are required clinical rotations at Richmond University Medical Center ER and ride-alongs on a 911 Ambulance. Alternate out of hospital experience will be arranged for students under 18. This program meets and exceeds the NYC Fire Department requirement for CFR certification for the civil service position of firefighter.

FEES:

The cost of tuition is **\$1095.00** which includes a <u>non-refundable application fee of **\$100.00**</u>, and is to be paid as follows: **\$195.00** to be paid with this application (the tuition is refundable with written notification 10 days prior to the start of the course <u>less the application fee</u>). The balance of **\$900.00** is due on the first day of class, payable by **Cash, PO or Bank Money Order ONLY**. <u>*Personal checks are NOT accepted*</u>. Tuition includes all books, handouts, AAOS web access practice tests, and access to download lectures. And personal protective equipment for clinical rotations. The student is required to obtain a medical exam and hold Student EMS Malpractice Insurance. The cost is \$42.00 direct from HPSO. See <u>www.HPSO.com</u> for policy details. Students under 18 will not be able to obtain this insurance so alternate arrangement will be made for them for clinical experience.
